A heron is a big fish-eating bird.

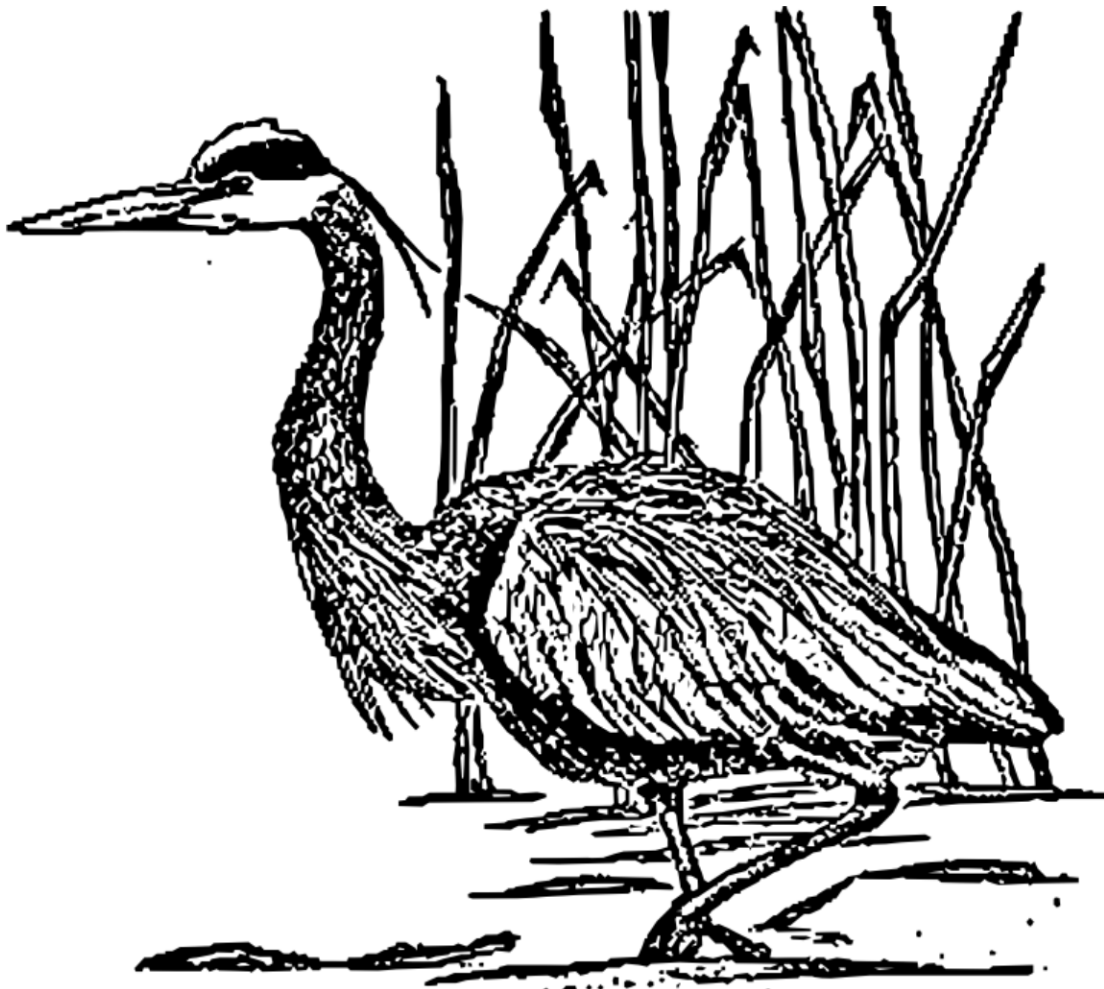
