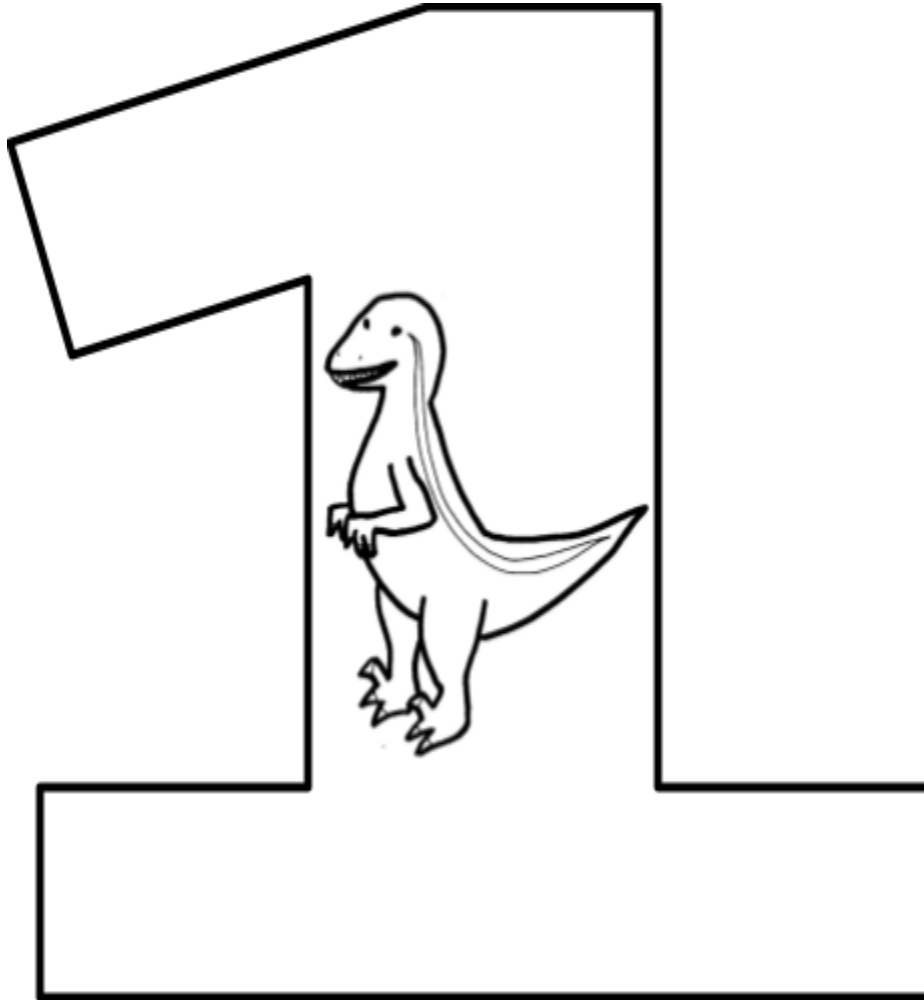

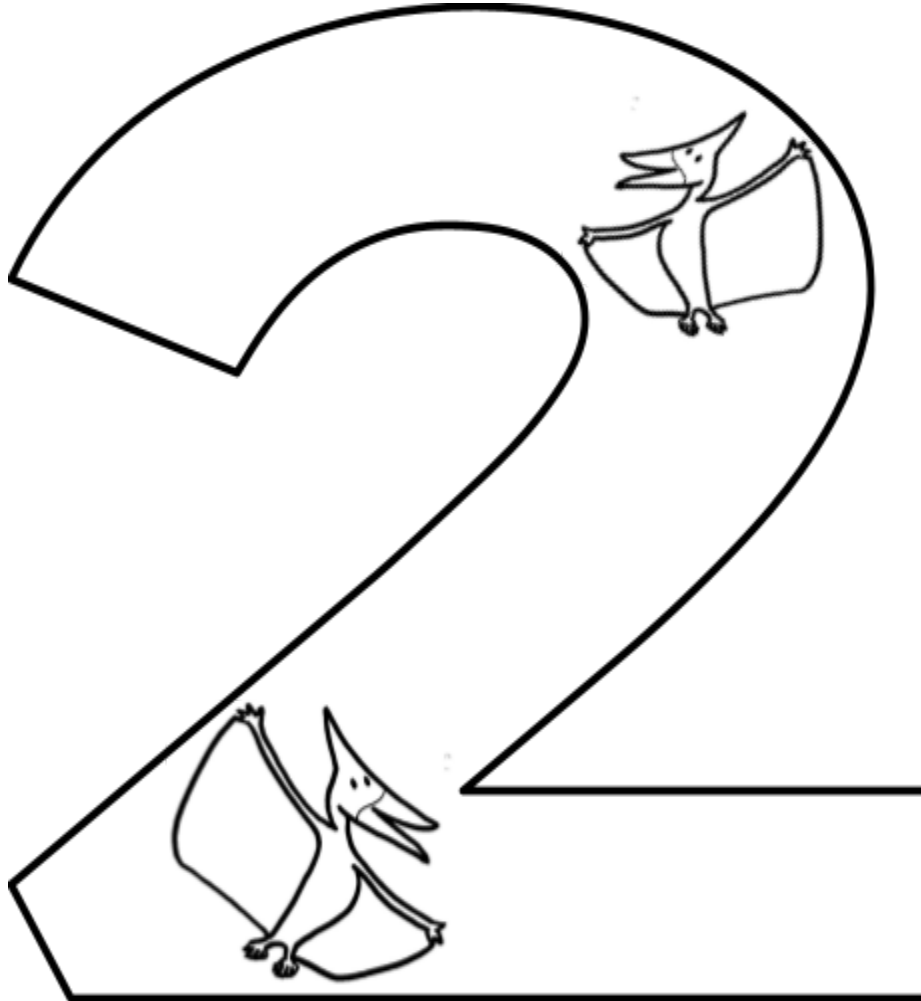

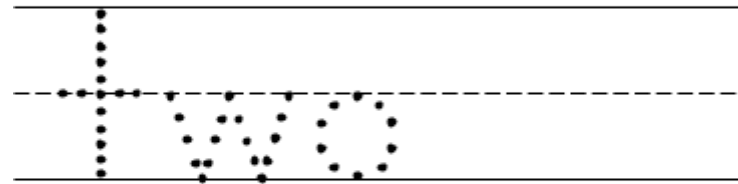
One Velociraptor

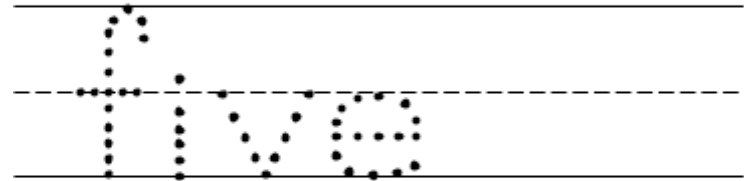
Four Brachiosaurus

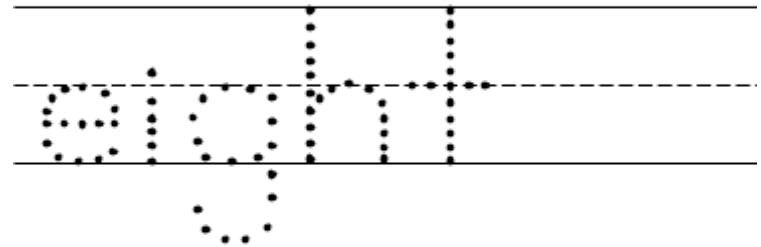
Seven Stegosaurus

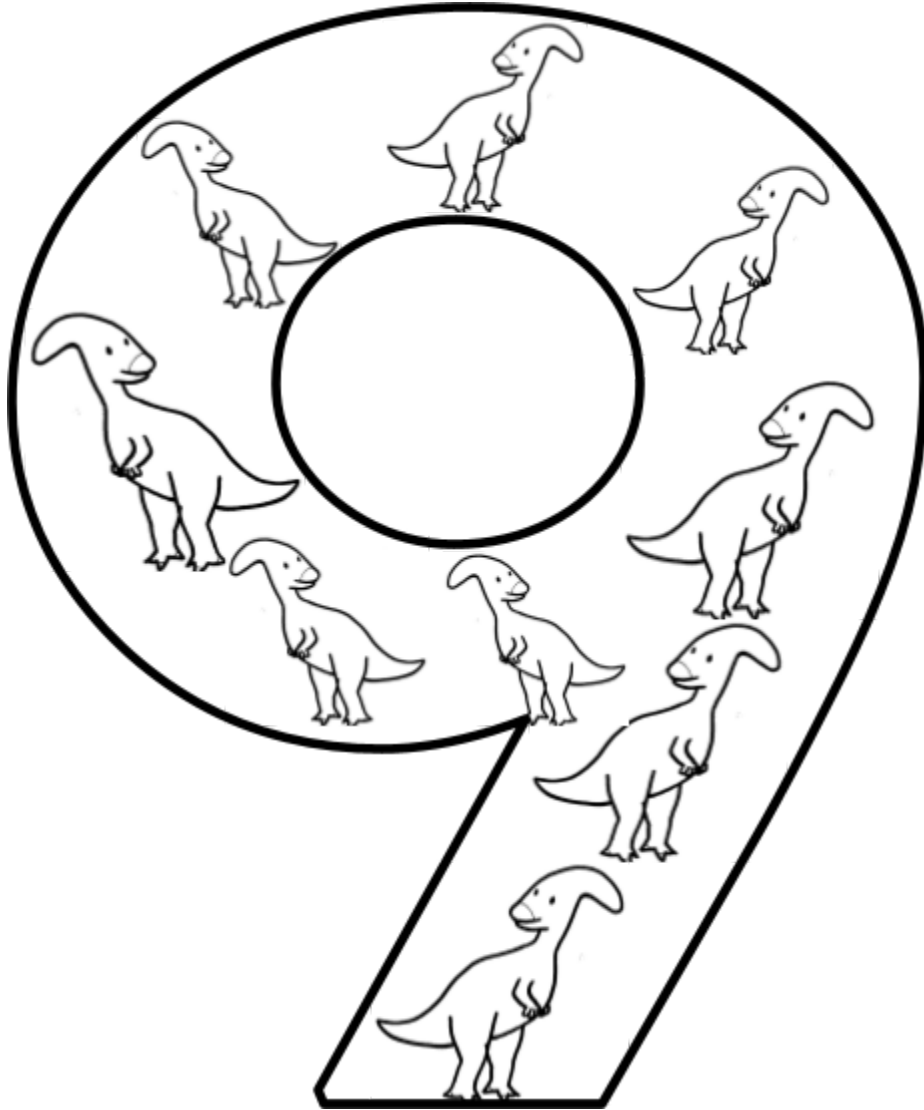

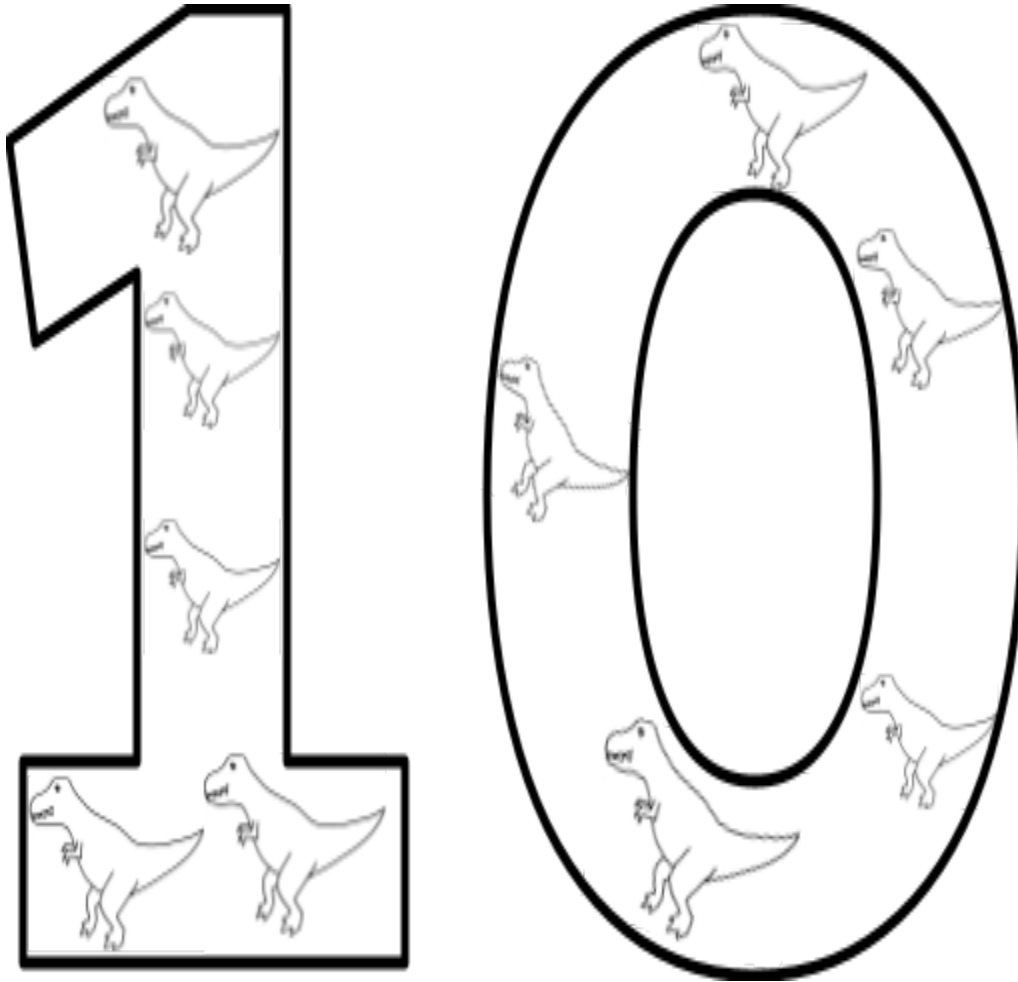
