Elijah

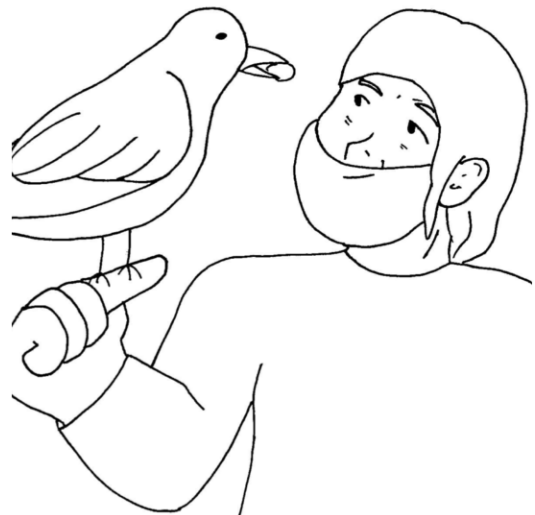
Children read the words in green and sight words in blue. Parents read the rest.
