## Activity 1: Jesus Prepares a Place for Us (John 14:3)

You Need:

☐ Building blocks

Say: "Jesus is preparing a place for us."

1. Have your child build a home. Remind your child that Jesus is preparing a place for those who love Him and try to obey Him. They accept Him as their Savior.



## Activity 2: Jesus Will Return (Acts 1:11, Revelation 1:7)

### You Need:

- ☐ Craft from "Spreading the Good News"-Activity 2.
- ☐ Jesus Returns printable
- ☐ Crayons or markers
- ☐ Glue
- ☐ Scissors

Say: "Do you remember that Jesus went to heaven? One day He will return, and everyone will know that He has returned!"

1. If you still have the craft from "Toddling Through God's Word: Spreading the Good News"-Activity 2, use that. If not recreate that craft.
2. Print the Jesus Returns printable at the end of this PDF.
3. Have your child color the picture of Jesus.
4. Assist your child in cutting out the picture of Jesus.
5. Glue the picture on top of the glitter.



### Activity 3: The Trumpet (1 Thessalonians 4:16)

#### You Need:

- ☐ 1 toilet paper rolls
- ☐ Yellow construction paper
- ☐ Straw
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Hot glue gun and stick

Say: "The Lord will come down from heaven when the trumpet call of God sounds."

1. Assist your child in cutting out yellow construction paper to cover the toilet paper roll.
2. An adult should use the hot glue gun to glue the yellow paper to the toilet paper roll.
3. Help your child cut out and roll a cone shape from the yellow paper.
4. An adult should use the hot glue gun to glue the yellow cone to the end of the toilet paper roll.
5. Use scissors to cut a mouthpiece and 3 buttons from the straw.
6. An adult should use the hot glue gun to attach the 3 buttons and mouthpiece.
7. Let your child pretend to play the trumpet.



Activity 4: Not Even the Angels Know when Jesus will Return (Matthew 24:36)

You Need:

- ☐ 2 vanilla wafer cookies
- ☐ Strawberry

Say: "No one knows when Jesus will return except for God. The angels do not know. People do not know."

1. Create the snack below out of 2 vanilla wafers and a strawberry.
2. The snack represents an angel. Not even the angels know when Jesus will return.
3. Let you child eat the snack.



### Activity 5: Jesus is King (Revelation 19:16)

#### You Need:

- ☐ Yellow paper
- ☐ Various colors of paint
- ☐ Black marker

Say: "Jesus is King! Jesus will always be King! No one is more powerful than Jesus!"

1. Assist your child in cutting out a crown shape from the yellow paper
2. Write, "Jesus is King" on your child's crown.
3. Have your child decorate the crown with finger paint prints. The prints represent jewels.
4. Measure the crown to your child's head. Tape the crown, so it will stay the correct size.
5. Remind your child that Jesus is the King!
