

Toddling Through God's Word: Adam and Eve

"God had a Plan" to the tune of "Hot Cross Buns"

God has a plan. God has a plan.

Sometimes we disobey, but God has a plan.

Activity 1: God created people. (Genesis 1:27, 2:7, 18-22)

You Need:

- 2 toilet paper rolls
- Green construction paper cut into leaf shapes
- Markers
- Glue
- Yarn
- Scissors

Say: "God created people in His own image. He created male and female. He created Adam and Eve."

1. Assist your child in drawing eyes, a nose, and a mouth on the toilet paper rolls. These will be Adam and Eve.

2. Let your child glue on the construction paper leaves as clothes for Adam and Eve.

3. Help your child cut the yarn into small pieces to create hair. Glue on hair for Adam and Eve. Glue on a beard and mustache for Adam if you would like.



Activity 2: The Garden (Genesis 2:8-17)

You Need:

- The same shoe box from God's Creation
- Adam and Eve toilet paper rolls
- 1 more toilet paper roll
- Green tissue paper
- Small pom poms or pieces of paper that represent fruit

Say: "God placed Adam and Eve in the garden. Everything was perfect. There was no pain or suffering. God gave Adam and Eve one rule. They should not eat from the tree of knowledge."

1. Wad the green tissue paper into a ball to create the top of a tree. Place that on top of the toilet paper roll.

2. Help your child glue on the pom poms or

pieces of paper that represent the fruit.

3. Place the tree, Adam, and Eve toilet paper rolls into the box.



Activity 3: The Snake (Genesis 3:1-8)

You Need:

- The same shoe box, Adam, Eve and tree
- Pipe cleaner
- Scissors

Say: "There was a snake in the garden. The snake was sneaky. The snake did not obey or respect God. Eve listened to the snake. She ate the fruit. Then Adam ate the fruit. Adam and Eve disobeyed God."

1. Help cut the pipe cleaner into the size of a snake.

2. Place the snake in the box.

3. Let your child play out the story above.

Activity 4: Consequences of Sin (Genesis 3:9-24)

You Need:

- The same shoe box, Adam, Eve, tree, and snake
- 2 brown pieces of paper
- Glue

Say: "God made Adam and Eve leave the garden. God is a just God. There was a consequence for disobeying. God is also a merciful God. He made a plan

to save His people."

1. Have your child take Adam, Eve, and the snake out of the box. Close the box.
2. Explain to your child that Jesus is the plan. Say, "God's plan to save His people was Jesus. Jesus did not come immediately, but He did come at the right time."
3. Glue two strips of paper on the top of the box to create the cross. Say, "This cross represents Jesus saving us."



Activity 5: Review (Genesis 2 and 3)

You Need:

- Snack of fruit

Say: "What do you remember from our story this week?"

1. Let your child retell the story. Use the props you have created if you want.
2. Say a prayer and eat the snack!
